FAQ

Who is eligible to apply to play in the Intermediate League?

Application to play in the under 10 Intermediate League shall be open to all boys and girls who are age eligible and desire to play intermediate soccer. Players born after the established deadline who will be entering the fourth grade may also apply to play in the Intermediate League.

How are the coaches for the Intermediate League selected?

Application to coach in the Intermediate League shall be open to all who demonstrate a commitment to the Intermediate League, who agree to adhere to the Intermediate League Guidelines, and who agree to participate in Intermediate League coaching sessions, education programs and evaluations. Coaching applicants will participate in an interview process with the Assistant Director of Coaching. After completion of the interview process, coaches will be selected by the Assistant Director of Coaching.

How are players grouped into selection pools?

All players who submit an application by the established deadline will be grouped into selection pools by geographic areas. These areas are determined by a player's **home** address.

How does the evaluation process work?

The selection process will be conducted primarily by the assigned team coach. No formal tryouts will be held. The selection process may include observation and/or consultation with players' coaches. Every attempt shall be made to conduct this process in a fair and unbiased manner.

How and when are players notified if they are placed on an intermediate team?

Players selected for an 'active' team roster will be notified by their assigned coach after roster approval by the Assistant Director of Coaching. All other players will be notified of their status as 'inactive' or alternate players, in writing, prior to registration for the fall season.

What does being an alternate mean?

Alternate's are 'inactive' players that have gone through the evaluation process but are not selected to an active team roster. These players will fill openings as they occur on active intermediate teams in between seasons. (November to February)

What is the cost to participate in the Intermediate League?

Player registration fees for the Intermediate League currently are **\$200.00** per player, per season. This fee also includes entry into both the spring and fall tournaments.

Playing in the Intermediate League is a one year commitment.

What is the cost of the ADIDAS Uniform Kit?

The cost of the kit (2 jerseys; black and white, one pair of Black shorts, and 2 pairs of socks; one black and one white) is \$50.00.

Will there be any traveling to Saturday games?

Yes, we inter-league with Greeley, Windsor and Loveland. There may be one or two games out of town. However most of the games will be played at home, at the FCSC Soccer Complex.

What is the difference between U-10 Developmental League and the Intermediate League?

The Intermediate League was designed for players of the appropriate age who are seeking an opportunity for enhanced training, education, and increased competition in order to advance the skills and abilities needed to play at the next level.
